Chief Chapman provided the board with a summary of the May and June response reports for CCIFD. There was a large hay fire in June.

Invoices for payment were presented (included in board packet for May and June; PolicyLogic, LLC (\$1,989.90); Angela Bertram, CPA (\$325).

Vaughn answered general questions from the board regarding the budget. The contract cost from the City of Chandler was \$1,117,796. The proposed tax rate is 1.5413, with a tax levy of \$920K.
